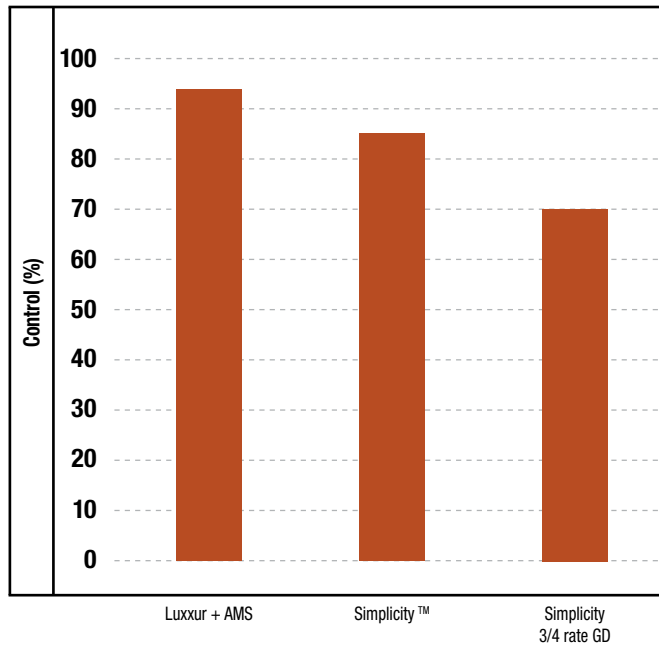

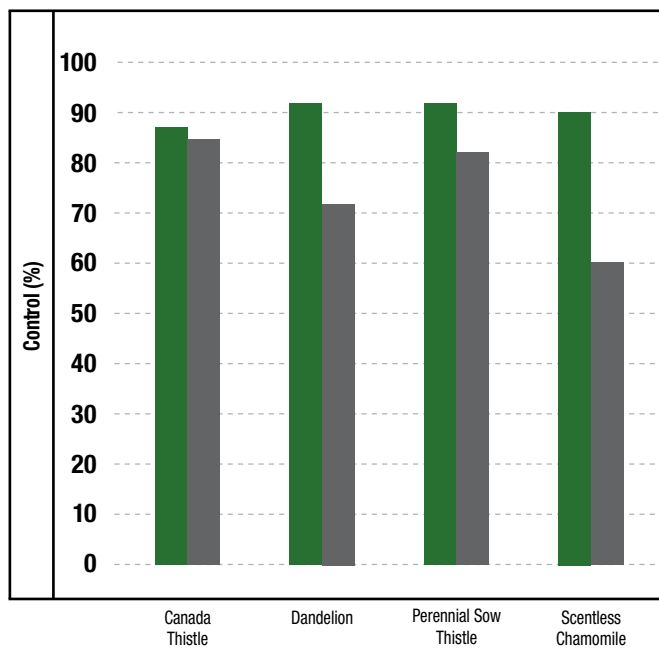
WILD OATS CONTROL SUMMARY

¹ For control of Canada thistle, perennial sow thistle and lamb's- quarters, the addition of an additive is required as follows:
a. **Spring and winter wheat:** add ammonium sulphate at 500 g/ha (99%) or 1 L/ha (49% solution) or 1.25 L/ha (40% solution). If using an ammonium sulphate product with a different concentration, adjust the rate accordingly.
b. **Durum wheat:** add a non-ionic surfactant (Agral 90, AgSurf or Surf 92) at 0.25%.

² Season long control, with some regrowth in the fall.
