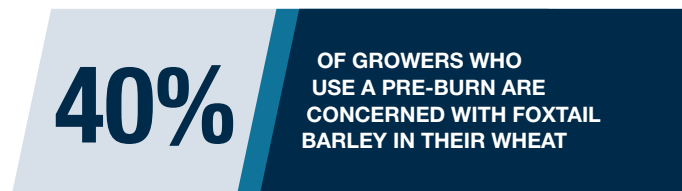
A recent survey indicates that foxtail barley continues to be one of the most problematic and costly weeds across the Prairies with approximately 50 percent of Canadian wheat growers responding that it has become increasingly difficult to control over the last five years. 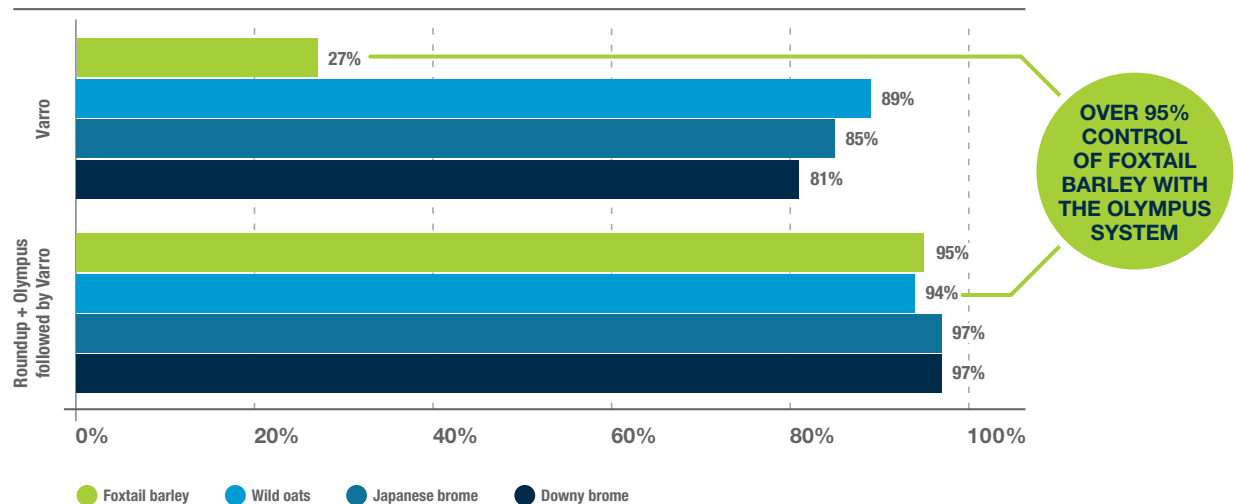
