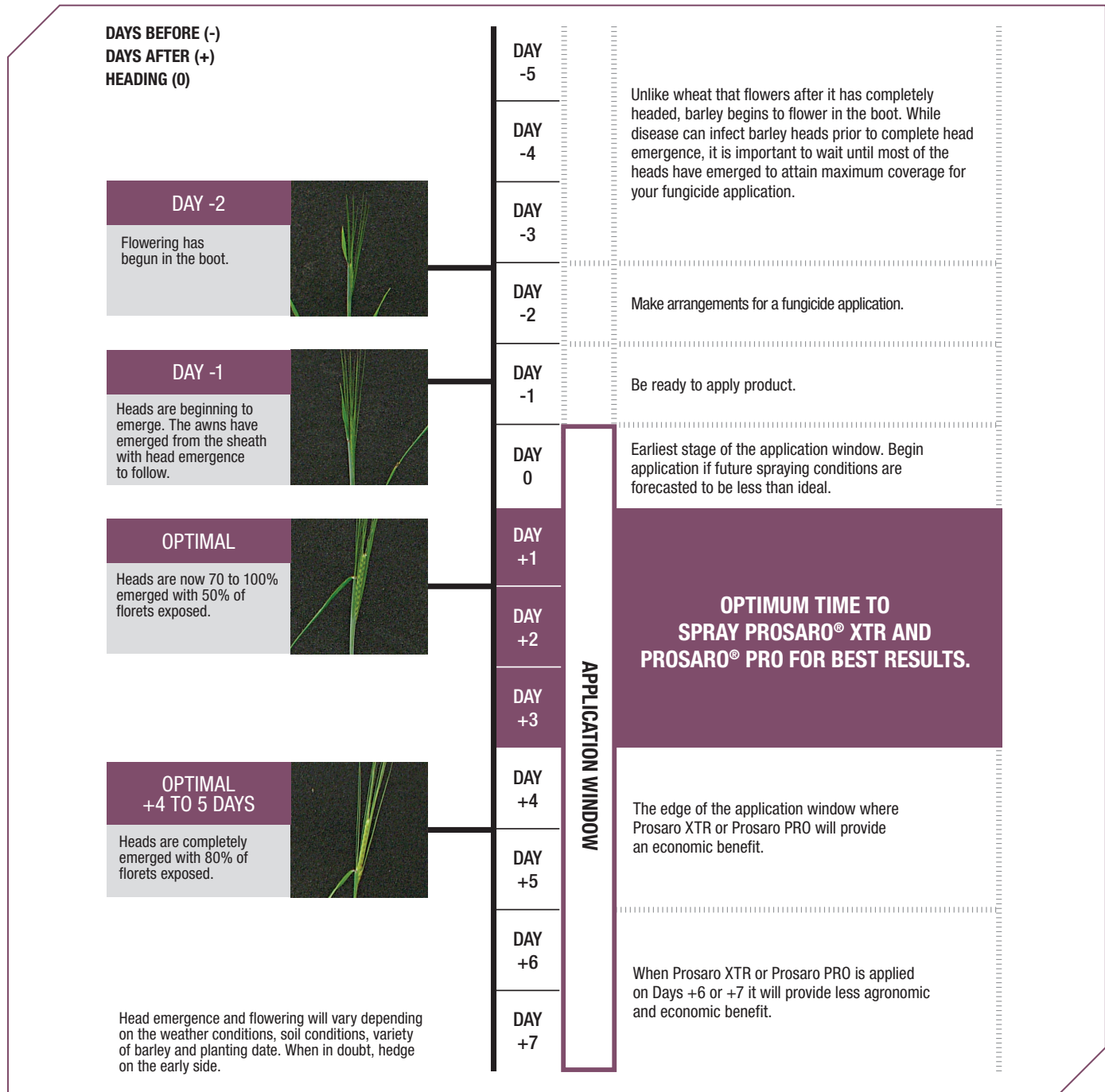


# BARLEY HEAD TIMING FUNGICIDE GUIDE

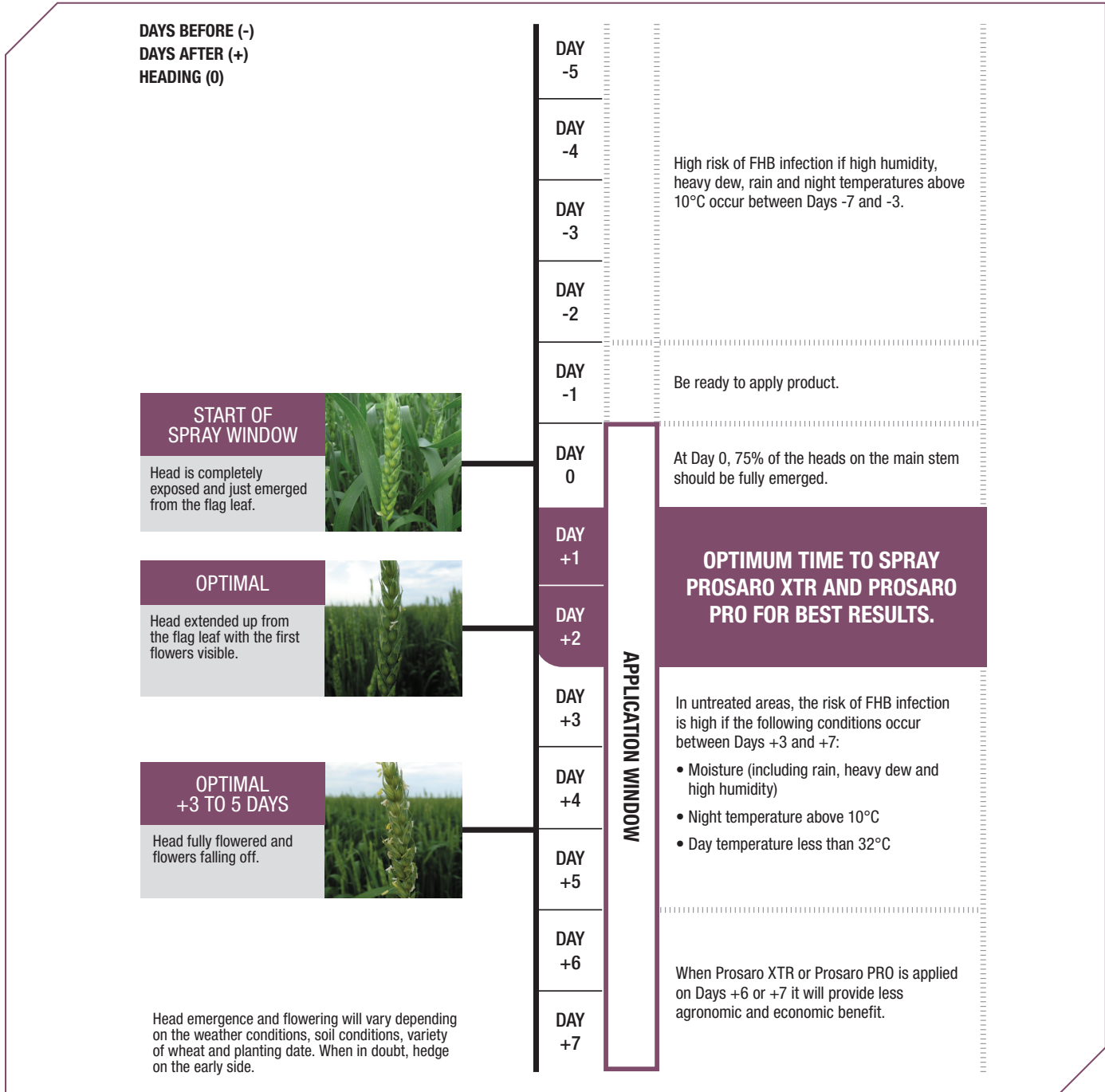
